Dear Parents/Guardians:

I would like to welcome us all back to school. I hope the children had a fun filled and restful summer. I pray and hope for another healthy and successful year for all of us. Just a reminder that, if you have not sent in the health forms that was in your child's registration packet, please do as soon as possible. Thank you to the families that have already sent in theirs.

**Please note that both new and returning students are required to complete a health history update each year; informing the school of any health changes such as new allergies, surgeries, etc; since last school year. If your child had a physical over the break, I greatly appreciate you sending the records to school.**

In general, these are the forms needed to be completed by every student, both new and returning, by the first week of school. All forms can be printed off the School's website under school nurse.

- Nursing Services permission and confidentiality assurance form signed by a parent, permitting the Nurse and school employees to render services to your child when needed: also informing you that whatever health records you share with the school remains confidential is only shared with other school employees if necessary to ensure the safety of your child.
- Health History form updating the school of any health changes
- Physical examination form required by all Pre-K<sub>3</sub>, Pre-K<sub>4</sub>, Kindergarten, 3, 6 and 8 as well as all new students regardless of grade. The universal physical/health form is gladly accepted if that is completed by the doctor instead.
- Annual Dental examination form recommended for all students.
- Immunization, all Pre-K<sub>3</sub> have to be up to date before entering school and Pre-k<sub>4</sub> students need the Dtap, Polio and MMR boosters. Both Pre-K<sub>3</sub> and Pre-K<sub>4</sub> students are required to have annual influenza shots between Sept. 1<sup>st</sup> and Dec. 31<sup>st</sup> until they are above the age of 59 months.
- One (1) dose of Tdap and one (1) dose of Meningococcal vaccines are required for all 6<sup>th</sup> graders.
- Only students Transferring from certain other countries are required to do TB (mantoux) testing.
- Depending on a student's health needs **other forms may be required besides the above. I will request them if necessary.**
- **New medication orders are required from the doctor each year with parent's authorization forms. All medicines sent to school must have original packaging with the pharmacy label.**

**For your child's safety, it is important that the forms are submitted sooner than later**
