We are in the process of re-registration for the 2022-2023 school year. The re-registration paperwork is due in to the office by **February 28**, and fees will come out that day via FACTS. If you are not returning for the 2022-2023 school year, the office must be notified by **February 16** and an exit interview needs to be scheduled.

Finally, even though numbers are going down, we still have students out for COVID related reasons. I would like to remind all parents that once the office receives notification of the absence, teachers get 24 hours to prepare information to post online for the student. Some teachers are able to post sooner, but that is not always the case depending on the type of assignment and what materials are needed. Teachers will make your child aware of how work will be posted within 24 hours of notification that they student will be out. Teachers also have 24 hours to respond to parent/student correspondence, especially emails that are sent outside of normal school hours.


