An email was also sent home today that contained a survey for our new uniforms. Reponses must be received by March 9. I will let everyone know what our new uniforms will be.

Dear St. Stanislaus Kostka Families.

On March 7, 2022, the schools of the Diocese of Metuchen will no longer require that students and teachers wear masks in the schools. We are pleased that the number of COVID 19 cases have diminished to a point that we are able to make masks optional in the schools. Any employee or student that wants to continue to wear a mask is welcome to do so, and should be fully supported by the school administration. In an ongoing effort to maintain the health and well-being of all those in our schools, we will be guided by the following:

- 1. During periods of elevated community transmission, when the COVID-19 Activity Level Index (CALI) is very high—RED, or high -ORANGE, the school should consider universal masking for all, especially if there is any difficulty in incorporating other safety measures such as adequate distancing or adequate ventilation.
- 2. During an active outbreak in a school, or in a general increase in cases of COVID-19, the school should consult with the local health department to determine if short term masking for all or for specific classrooms should be required.
- 3. Anyone testing positive for COVID-19 will be required to quarantine. That person may either quarantine for 10 days, or return after 5 days with a mask for days 6 - 10.
- 4. If a student rides the bus, the students must follow the guidelines presented by the bus. If there is a mask requirement, the student is obligated to abide by that regulation.
- 5. In the case of school field trips, students will be obligated to follow the guidelines presented by the site being visited. If they required masks, students will be obligated to abide by that regulation.

As always, things may change when new guidelines are announced. I will keep you posted at to any changes. Should you have any questions about the information provided, please feel free to contact the school office.


