Grade 4- stuffing mix

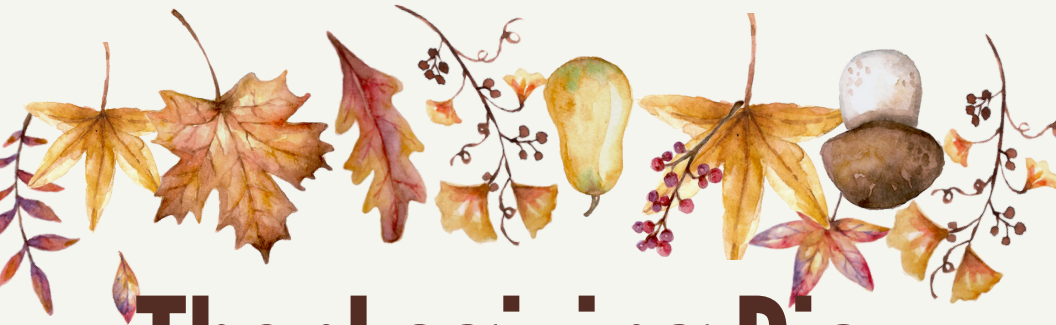
Grade 5- juice (in plastic bottles or cans)

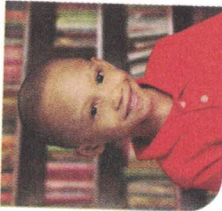

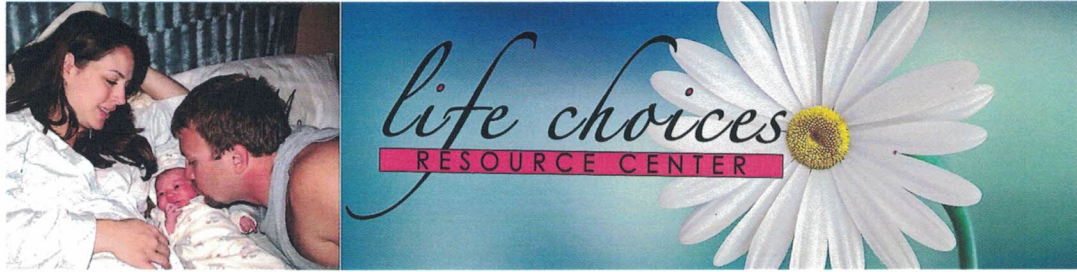

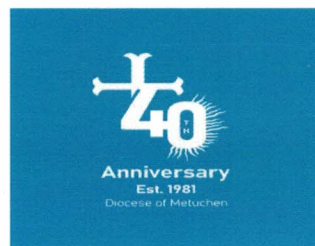

MODERNA COVID-19 VACCINE BOOSTER CLINICS NOW OPEN FOR ELIGIBLE NEW JERSEY RESIDENTS

By Appointment Only; No Walk-Ins

Saint Peter's is now accepting appointments to Moderna COVID-19 booster vaccine clinics for eligible New Jersey residents. To determine eligibility, visit <https://covid19.nj.gov/faqs/nj-information/testing-and-treatment/who-should-get-a-booster-shot-or-third-dose-of-the-covid-19-vaccine>

Moderna COVID-19 booster vaccine clinics will be held **by appointment only** from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. in the Sister Marie de Pazzi Conference Center at Saint Peter's University Hospital, 254 Easton Avenue, New Brunswick, NJ, on:

Monday, November 15
Wednesday, November 17
Tuesday, November 23
Monday, November 29

Eligible New Jersey residents who completed their initial series of the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine six (6) months ago or longer, are 65 or older or a long-term care resident, an adult (age 18-64) with underlying medical conditions, or an adult (age 18-64) at increased risk of COVID-19 exposure because of their job or living situation, i.e., healthcare workers; education staff (including teachers, support staff and daycare workers); first responders (including firefighters and police); public transit workers; U.S. postal service workers; and clergy.
