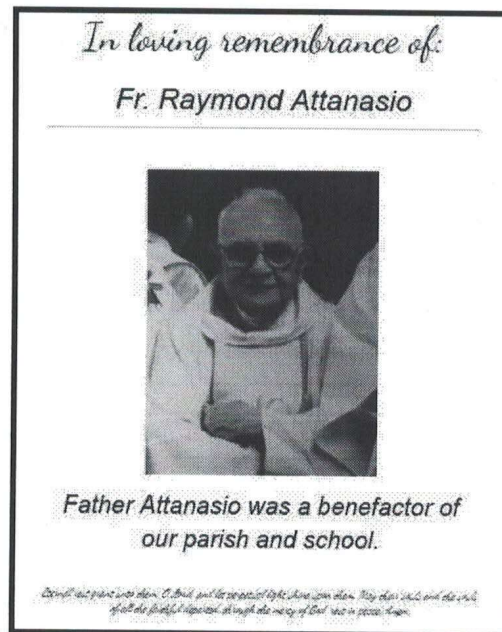
Dear Parents/Guardians,

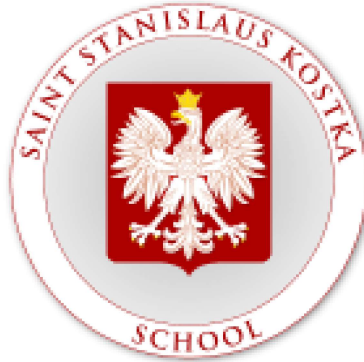
Completed templates need to be returned to your child's homeroom teacher no later than Monday, October 23rd. Should you have any questions, please contact the main office.

3RD ANNUAL Flags for Heroes Fundraiser



St. Stanislaus Kostka School will be displaying flags around the school this November to honor those who served and are currently serving our country as members of our military. The flags will also honor our local heroes such as police, firefighters, EMS, and all frontline workers.

The cost to sponsor a 3' x 5' flag, which will be displayed on an 8' pole, is \$100.00. Each flag will include an 8.5" x 11" laminated sign that indicates the sponsor or dedication. Each flag will be illuminated after dark by the lighting on our school property.

The proceeds of the Flags for Heroes Fundraiser will go towards the school boiler/AC fundraising project for the 2023-2024 school year. From the proceeds, 10% will be donated to the Menlo Park Veterans Memorial Home.
