Here are some reminders for the evening.

1. Students should be dressed up. No jeans, sweats or t-shirts.
2. Students should report to the bleachers and their homeroom teacher at 6:45 in grades K-8. Parents should take their children's coats with them to their seats so they do not get lost on the bleachers.
3. Preschool students should report directly to the preschool room at 6:45, as soon as the preschool class is done with their performance parents should pick them up from the preschool room. Students are welcome to stay with their parents for the remainder of the program.
4. At the conclusion of the show parents should pick their children up from the bleachers. Teachers will not release students to find you.
