Spread Joy this Christmas for Families in Need

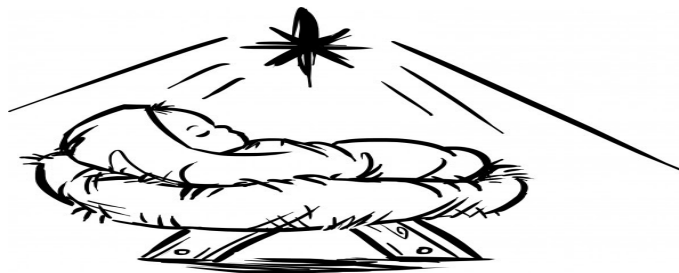
