Dear St. Stans' School Family,

It has come to my attention that there has been some concern in reference to the potential of a student being in the building whose parent tested positive for COVID. I want you to rest assured that based on the information this office has this is completely inaccurate. The proper precautions have been taken, and any student who has had direct contact with a positive case of COVID is on quarantine.

The safety and well-being of our students and faculty are my top priorities, and any information that we receive is taken seriously. Decisions to quarantine are appropriately made to ensure a safe school environment. This is certainly a reminder for all our St. Stans' families to remain vigilant about notifying the office of any potential contacts with COVID positive patients, and to keep students at home who are exhibiting any symptoms no matter how minor they may seem.

Please remember we will be back in school virtually from **January 5-8**. Our in-person instruction will begin on **January 11**, which is an 11:50 dismissal day.

I have also worked with Dr. Labbe, the Sayreville Superintendent, to make COVID testing available for our students and families at Sayreville War Memorial High School. Attached are documents explaining the testing procedures, along with testing dates. The test will be available on Thursdays, starting **December 30**, from 3:30-6:30 PM.

Finally, thank you so much for all of your very thoughtful gifts. Your generosity is overwhelming! My prayers for the health and well-being of all of our families is with each of you as we leave for our Christmas break. May this holiday be a restful and happy one for each of you, and may the New Year bring peace and health for all of us.

These are days off, there will be no instruction virtual or otherwise.



Good evening. This is to remind you that beginning on **Wednesday, December 30th**, our students, their parents, and anyone else residing in their household can participate with us in free (no out of pocket costs) and easy access **asymptomatic COVID-19 testing**. Testing will take place in **Sayreville War Memorial High School Auxiliary Gym B**. However, in order to be tested you **must** first **register, sign a consent form, and participate in a 3-5 minute telemedicine appointment with a physician**. After your telemedicine appointment, you will receive an email with a **prescription** signed by a physician for testing. While participants can get tested **as many times as they would like**, please note that **you must bring your prescription to testing and that no one will be permitted to test or receive lab results unless they have a valid prescription**. Thus after participating in every test, you **must refill your prescription by participating in another telemedicine appointment**. Finally, click **here** for questions about if you receive a check, statement of benefits, and/or an invoice from your insurance company.

Although the first date of student/family testing is set for a **Wednesday, December 30th** because we do not think anyone will want to do so on New Year's Eve, testing for students and the family members that reside with them will take place after that in the **late afternoon/early evening on Thursdays**. Thus, we will test students and their family members from **3:30 – 6:30 pm**. If you would like to be tested on Wednesday December 30th or on any of the other designated Student/Family dates afterward, simply click on this link (<https://backtoworksolutions.com/SayrevilleCommunity.html>) so that you can register and provide consent. Shortly after you register, a representative will email you regarding the scheduling of your telemedicine appointment. After your appointment, your prescription will be emailed to you and you will be instructed on how to register for a testing time on the designated date you desire.

In addition, due to the increase in **staff and family** being tested on **Wednesdays**, we have expanded the testing time on all future Wednesdays by 30 minutes from 12:30 -2:30 pm to **12:30- 3:00 pm**. Below please find the tentative schedule based on these changes.

- Thursday, January 14, 2020 (1:00 – 3:00 pm for **staff/family** and **3:30 – 6:30 pm** for **students/family**)
- Wednesday, January 20, 2020 (12:30 – **3:00 pm** for **staff/family**)
- Thursday, January 21, 2020 (1:00 – 3:00 pm for **staff/family** and **3:30 – 6:30 pm** for **students/family**)

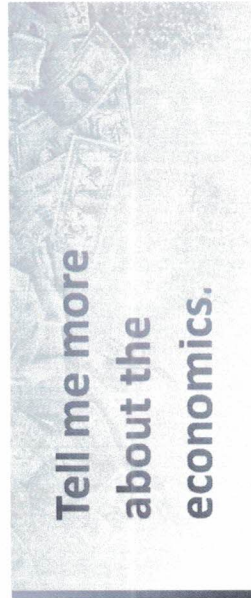
What is BackToWork's Role?

BTW will create the registration portal, facilitate the Tele-Med evaluation, coordinate the Lab partner for clinician nasal swab and blood draw (antibody only) collections on testing days and lab analysis and facilitate the results delivery in detail individually as well as in summary to the School.



What are the School's Responsibilities?

Schools will need to leverage their expertise to communicate and encourage registration, organize day-to-day logistics testing and maintain open communication.



Tell me more about the economics.

There are a few parties to a successful COVID-19 test regiment. Patients (including teachers, staff, students and sometimes family members), the School itself, the TeleMedicine Health Care Provider (TMHP), the Laboratory and BackToWork (BTW). When patients participate in the TeleMed Evaluation, their insurance company will normally make a payment to the TMHP on their behalf. Next, as these patients then provide the Lab with a nasal swab or other sample, their insurance company will normally make a second payment to the Lab on their behalf. BTW coordinates the whole process and is usually compensated by the TMHP. Please refer to the Coordination of Services Agreement for further details.
