Dear St. Stanislaus Kostka Families,

Having a sunny, 50 degree day is certainly a welcomed change to all of the snow we have been experiencing. The students finally had an opportunity to go outside for recess, which was long overdue.

Virtual learning parameters are being sent home in the white envelope today. I know this can be confusing, and frustrating, so I hope this helps to explain things a little better.

MAP testing will continue until **March 5**. We ask that your child arrive at school on time for these testing days. If they arrive after a test has already begun, they will not be admitted into the class until the testing is complete.

The additional re-registration information that went home last week is due **February 26**. This is also the date that academic fees for next year will be taken out of your FACTS account. Should you have any questions please contact the office. Also included in this virtual white envelope is information about financial aid. The deadline for filing is **March 31**. We have provided the financial aid website links on our school website.

Finally, we will also be attending Stations of the Cross as a school for the first time tomorrow, and all throughout Lent. Thank you to Mrs. Foret and the eight-grade for facilitating this. Lenten mission boxes also went home this week, and are due back by **March 25**. Our school will also be doing another service project this Lenten season called "Blankets of Hope." More information on that program will be sent home soon.

Virtual Instruction Policy

- Virtual instruction is only offered to those students who are home due to a positive case of COVID, students who are quarantining due to direct contact exposure to COVID, or those students who are awaiting COVID test results. Should your child need virtual instruction, 24 hours' notice must be given to the office in order for the teacher to prepare. Technology needs to be set-up and materials often need to be scanned.
- If your child simply has a cold, headache, stomach ache, etc., they will simply be absent from school. Virtual instruction is not available for things that are not COVID related.
- If your child is sent home from school because they are not feeling well and are experiencing COVID symptoms, we urge you to have him/her tested to rule out COVID. They will not be allowed to join virtual instruction when they are home.
- We understand that not all symptoms necessarily mean a positive case of COVID, but in accordance with the CDC, students need to be kept home/sent home from school if they are experiencing any potential COVID symptoms.

Thank you, as always, for your continued support and cooperation during this uncertain time. The safety of our students and staff continue to be our top priority here at St. Stanislaus Kostka School. If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to contact the office.

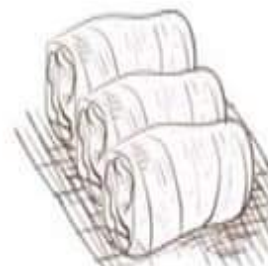

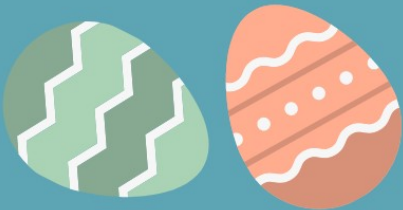
