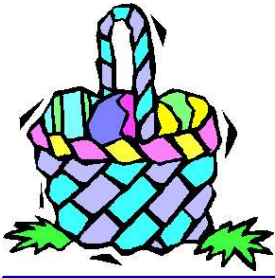

Finally, please keep our second-grade in your prayers, as they will be receiving their First Penance tonight.

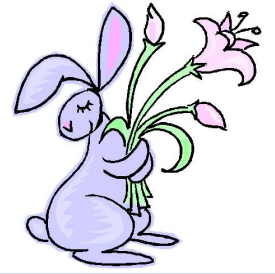
Stay safe everyone, and as always you are in my prayers. I wish you all a very blessed Easter!

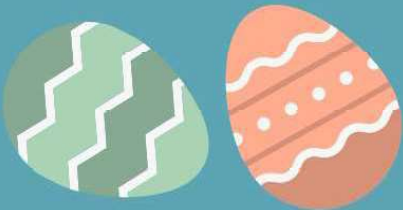

Any amount is appreciated.

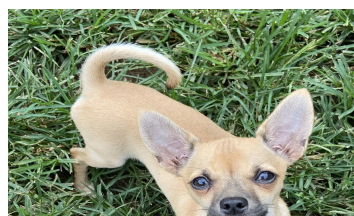
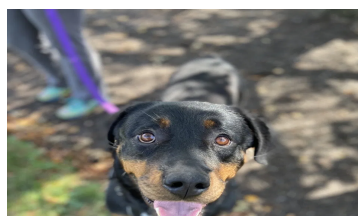
Please send donations to Mrs. Grover. Checks can be made out to St. Stan's School. We will be making our school donation online.
