## **Saint Stan's School Children's Mass**

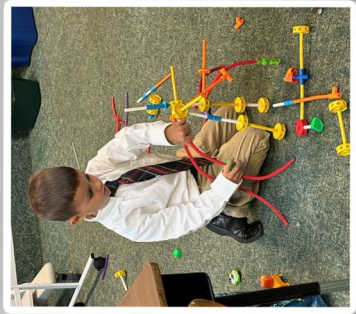
