Dear Parents/Guardians:

This is to inform you that the students' health screenings will begin next week. Your child would be pulled out of class for a brief moment to be screened: most likely during gym.

Screening includes:

- Blood pressure, height, and weight measurements for all grades,
- Audio and Vision test for Pre-K through 8th grades;
- Scoliosis screening for grades 5, 6, 7 and 8 (please read note below)

A referral will be sent home for further evaluation by a doctor for any health concerns.

*Regarding Scoliosis screening, a student may be exempted upon written request by a parent/guardian. Parents requesting exemption are advised to have their child checked bi-annually by their family physician. An exemption letter is attached for grades 5-8. Please sign and return to the nurse's office by 10/22/24 if you do not want your child screened for scoliosis at school. Your consent is assumed if the form is not signed and returned by the date.

Scoliosis Screening Exemption Letter

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Scoliosis is a lateral curvature of the spine which is most commonly detected during the adolescent growth period. It is estimated that 5% to 10% of school children have such a curvature to some varying degrees. However, only about 2% of these curvatures are significant. If someone else in the family has scoliosis, the likelihood of incidence is much higher – approximately 20%. The effect of scoliosis depends upon its severity, how early it is detected, and how promptly it is treated.

By law, every NJ board of education must provide scoliosis screening of every student between the ages of 10 and 18, corresponding roughly to grades 5 through 12. The goal of this mass screening program is early detection, because curvatures can often be controlled if detected early. Students diagnosed with scoliosis should be under the care and supervision of a family healthcare provider or clinic. Referral to an orthopedist or orthopedic clinic may be indicated.

Appropriately, each student is screened individually in a well-lit private area. Proper screening procedure also requires that students expose their shoulders and back. Therefore, on the day of screening, students are advised to wear undershirt that will expose the shoulders under their school uniforms During screening, students are observed for symmetry of the shoulders, scapulae and waist as well as any hump in both upper and lower back. Screening is done by observation only; no touching is involved.

If you do not want your child screened at school, please sign below and return this letter to the school's office by October 22, 24. Your consent is assumed and your child will be screened for scoliosis if this letter is not signed and returned. You may also email the school to opt out.
