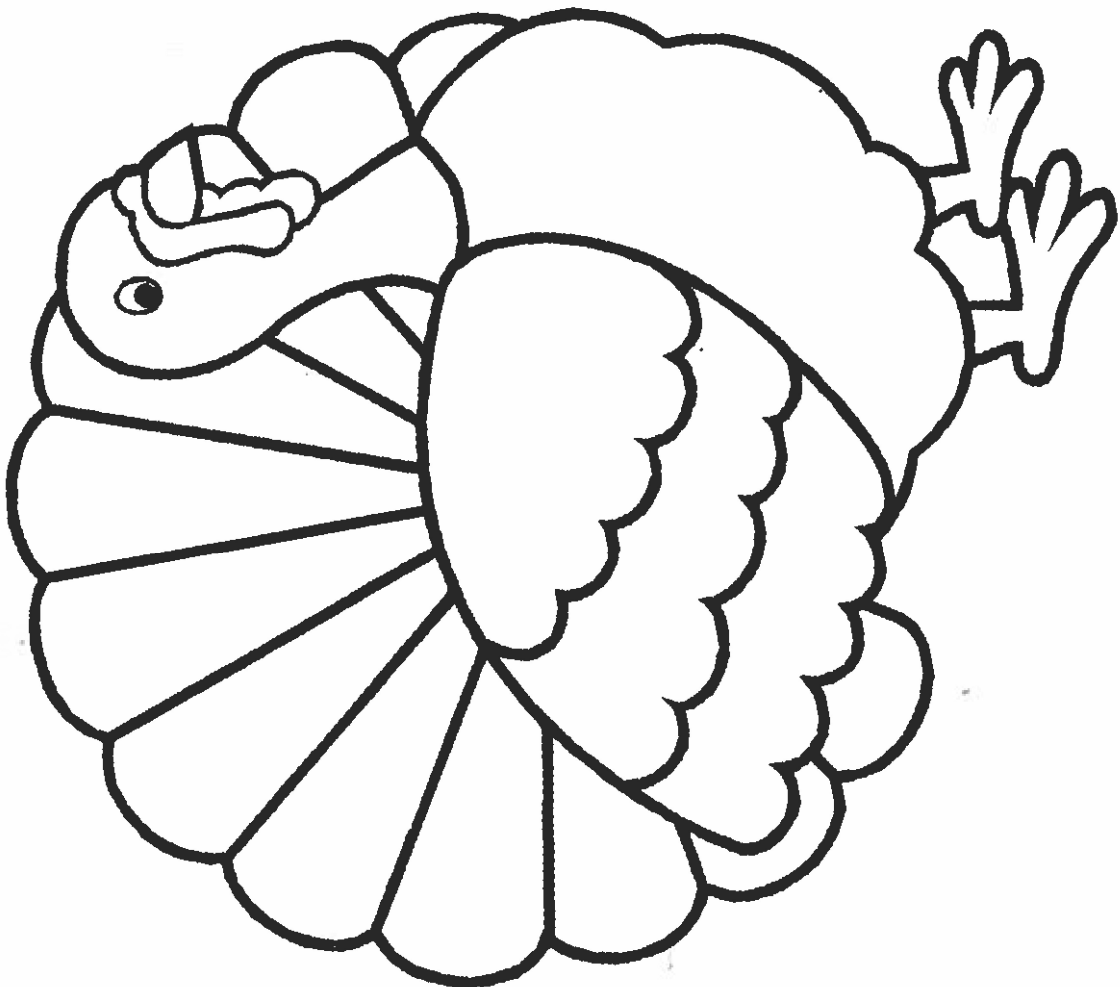
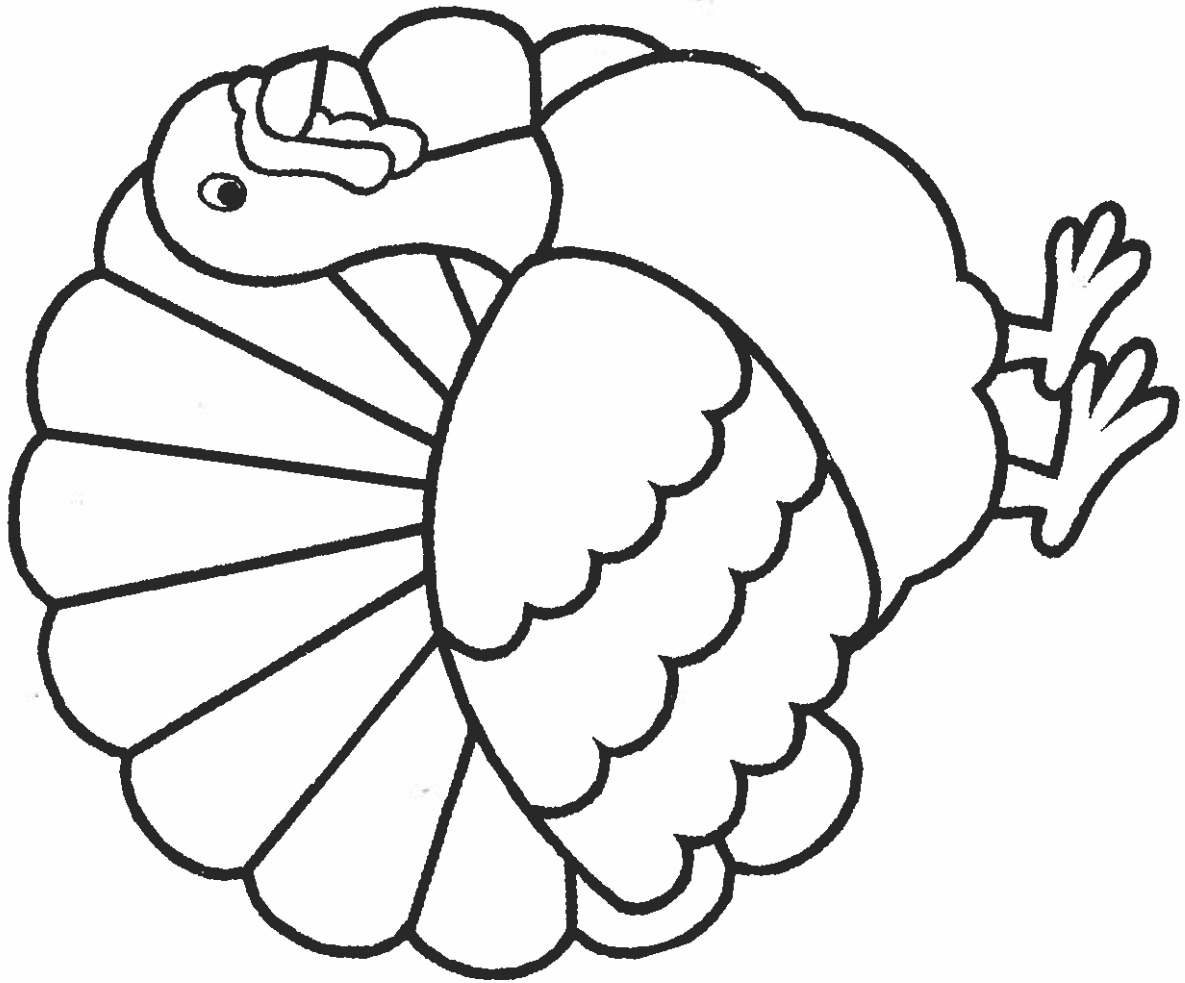

Please send in your child's item no later than November 20th along with \$1 to be used towards the purchase of a turkey. Your generosity is always appreciated.

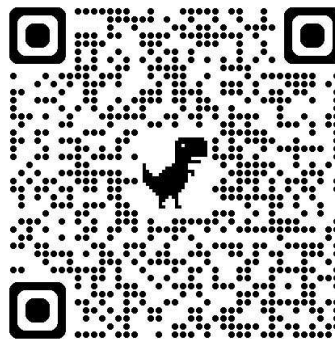


Christmas Card Nominations

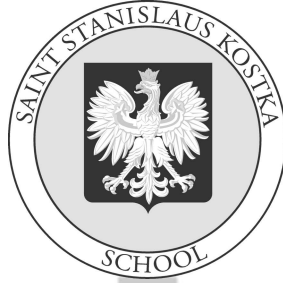

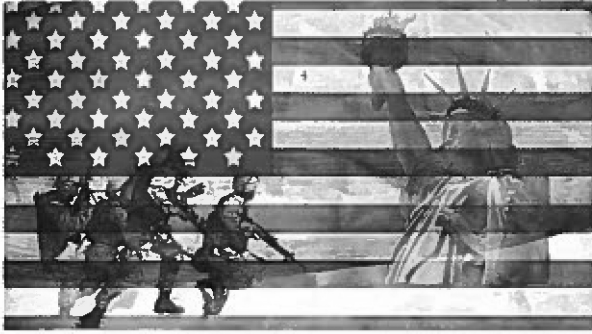
